



Women - The Builder of Character


As the woman is respected in the form of a 'Goddess of creation' so she is also responsible for the development and creation of life.

Not only has she achieved fame on earth, she has also reached the frontiers of space as well .


'Adi Shakti' and 'Woman'


Source of Adi Shakti - Anadi, Adi Pita



In this way, woman was exploited in many ways and became the victim of violence and discriminatory treatment. Her position started becoming like a pitiable-inferior mendicant. To get rid of pain due to such state of inequality many messengers started descending to deliver discourses about moral values. 
Complete Development with Women Empowerment
